The JUNO Concert Series celebrates Canadian songs, performed by collaborating Canadian artists. Past participants over the series' six-year history include Arkells, Billy Talent, Dream Warriors, July Talk, Maestro Fresh Wes, Platinum Blonde, Sloan and many others.

Advance tickets are \$20 and will be available via <u>Ticketfly.com</u>, Vertigo Records, and Compact Music locations. Tickets will also be available at the door for \$25.

The JUNO Concert Series kicks off ahead of JUNO Week 2017, taking place in Ottawa from March 27 to April 2, 2017. The weeklong celebration culminates with The 2017 JUNO Awards Broadcast on CTV on Sunday, April 2.
